### 3.5 **NATIONAL LIFE MEMBER**

National Life Membership may be conferred at a general meeting on a member of the Federation upon recommendation of the National Board of Directors; such membership to carry voting privileges but no obligation to pay dues.

3.5.1 On application from a Branch, a National Life Membership shall be granted to anyone who has been a Life Member of the Branch and at the time of submission:

- a) is a National Active Member in good standing who has reached the age of sixty (60) and has retired, and has been a member of the CCF for a minimum of ten (10) or more consecutive years; or
- b) is a National Active Member in good standing who has been declared permanently and totally disabled, regardless of age, provided that they were a member in good standing for five (5) or more years; or
- c) is a National Active Member in good standing who has completed twenty five (25) years of membership in good standing in the CCF, not necessarily consecutively, and regardless of employment status. (Halifax, 2001)

3.5.2 The submission to the CFCC should occur as soon as possible after the member has been announced in the local Branch minutes as a Life Member of this Branch, and that the award of the CCF National Life Membership will be announced at the next annual convention.

**NOTE: Any application for Life Membership will only be accepted when the proposed member is fully paid for the convention year to which the application is being presented and accepted.**
